## Purpose

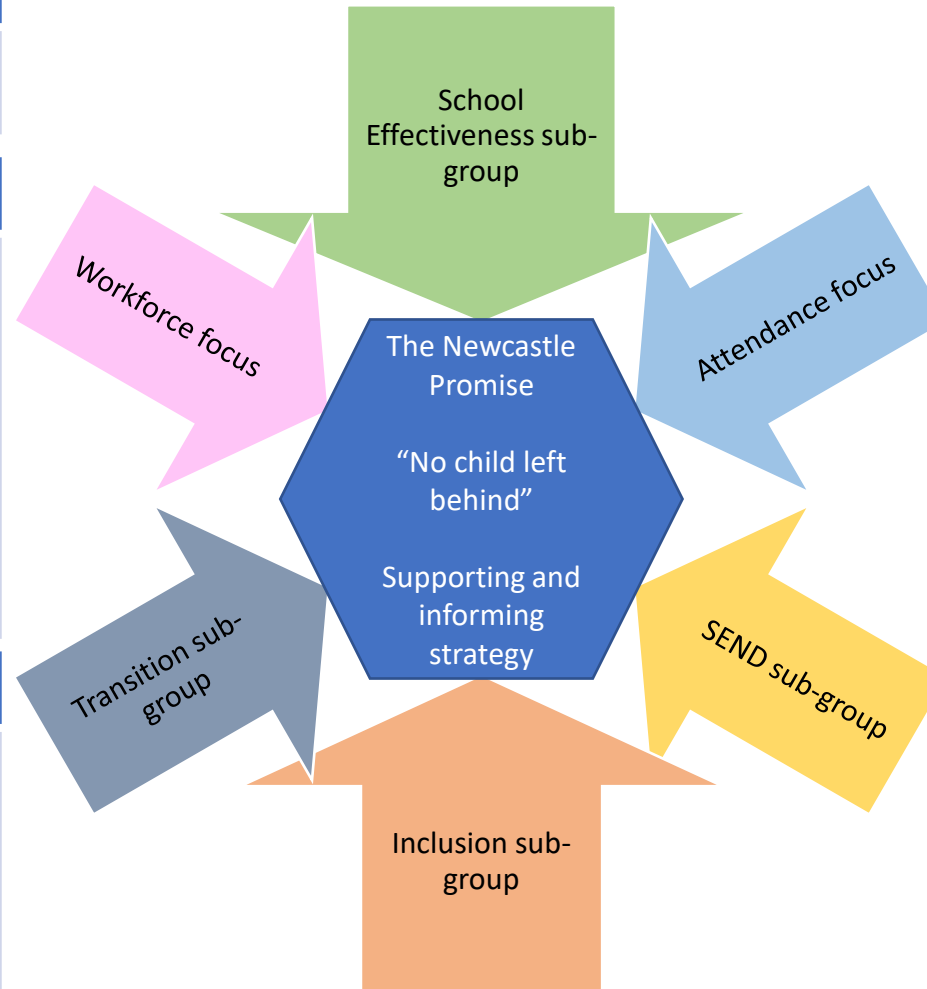
A city where we all share responsibility for providing the best educational opportunities for all our children and young people.
